Part 1: Brief Information


This appliance is part of the new and practical series – Gas Barbeque Burner. The appliance is appliacable for various creation of roasted food, resulting the colour, aroma, flavor and freshness. The roasted meat will be delicate and hygiene. This appliance adopt the new tiny bore porcelain fire plank, with the arc-shaped heated glass to radiate infrared. The glas stove surface can be cleaned easily. The flame is ignited with electric lighter and can be adjusted easily. It is easy and simple to use. This appliance is nice looking and practical. It has a high eficiency and environmentally friendly. This appliance can be used at home, supermarket, and for business.

Part 3: How to Use

- 1. Before operating, check for the gas pipe has connected the appliance and the gas cylinders and the connection is fine.
- 2. Pour water into the oil-residue basin and keep some water in it to avoid the drought.
- 3. Turn on the main gas valve, press the electronic lighter and turn it left, loose it when the fire is on, turn the fire switch to left or right to control the flame intensity.
- 4. After operating, shut down the fire switch and close the main gas valve.



Part 4: Important Safety Information

- 1. To prevent damage, handle with care when transporting. Do not put upside down, press heavily and bump too hard.
- 2. The appliance should use low- pressure valve, middle-pressure and high-pressure valve are prohibited.
- 3. When the gas leaks, shut down the main gas valve immediately, and ask the service station to mend it before use again.
- 4. When the gas leaked, shut down the main gas valve immediately, and call MODENA Call Center for any adjustment or maintenance.
- 5. When grilling, user should avoid the oil of the meat dropping down on the glass and stainless steel boards, or else may cause some oil fume.

Part 5: Cleaning & Maintenance

- 1. For your safety, shut down the fire switch before cleaning and maintaining.
- 2. When cleaning, the arc-shaped glass and the oil-residue dish can be removed to wash, and the surface of the appliance can be mopped by wet towel.
- 3. Use the steel needle to check whether the tiny bore porcelain fire plank is clogged.
- 4. Do not use water to wash the head of the appliance directly, it will effect the lifespan.
